## Position Overview:

The Math Specialist will also collaborate with colleagues while maintaining a positive team attitude.

## Job Responsibilities:

- Plan, organize, and implement reading lessons that support students in small group and/or one-on-one settings, collaborating closely with classroom teachers
- Provide math enrichment in small group settings allowing students that need additional challenge an opportunity to engage with math concepts in a more sophisticated way
- Provide one-on-one remediation to students with fragile mathematical profiles identified by classroom teacher and/or standardized testing
- Support teachers with relevant resources and materials to supplement or enhance reading curriculum
- Communicate effectively with parents, teachers, and administration
- Develop and maintain positive relationships with students, parents, teachers, and administration
- Upon request of a teacher or administration, observe students in literacy class and discuss findings to best support individual student needs
- Attend all required school meetings and public-relations events, including participate in school committees and extracurricular activities as required
- Engage in professional development to stay abreast of current topics in education
