## THE POWER OF POLYMERS

Have you heard of 3-D printing? Slime? Bouncy balls? Spherification? Well, those are just some of things polymers can do. In this class, students will play with some of the classic polymers when making slime, bouncy balls, and other things. We'll also explore modern gastronomy techniques as we make edible polymers. Then, we'll experiment with some cutting edge polymer use when we draw 3-Dimensional objects using a pen that operates in a similar fashion as a 3-D printer.

## SCRATCH AND SAM

This class will explore both SCRATCH programming and stop motion animation. SCRATCH programming introduces students to beginning programming in a kid-friendly interface. Many of the operations in SCRATCH use the same logic as more advanced programming languages. Students will learn how to put a character on the programming stage and then control that character using programming. SAM Animation was created under a partnership between Tufts University and the National Science Foundation to make digital story telling easy for children. Students will learn how to use simple cameras with the aid of SAM Animation software to create digital stop motion animation projects working with props, toys, drawings, clay, and miniature sets. Students can recreate their favorite movie or television scene, music video, or create their own digital story.
